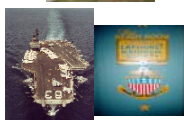

The Navy Lakehurst Information Center - Displays of material on the NAS Lakehurst Mission by The Historical Society.



The Ready Room - Highlights role of NAS Lakehurst in engineering aircraft take off & return systems on Aircraft Carriers. (Example: USS Kitty Hawk (CV 63))



The POW-MIA Room - Information on servicemen held captive in North Vietnam



Historic Hangar One - Once housed all active American Rigid Airships, USS Shenandoah, USS Los Angeles, and the USS Akron from 1922 to 1937.



The Hindenburg Crash Site Memorial Marker - German built airship that crashed at Lakehurst on May 6, 1937. Where 13 passengers, 22 crewmen and 1 civilian ground crew member of Lakehurst NJ lost their lives.
